Dear Neighbor:

As a resident of Cathedral City as well as a business and homeowner, I want to inform you about Measure B – Cathedral City's Local Control Measure.



Over the past five years, Sacramento politicians have taken nearly \$20 million from Cathedral City. Measure B ensures that Cathedral City continues to have a guaranteed source of local funding that cannot be taken by Sacramento and requires that our tax dollars are spent locally for Cathedral City residents – without raising taxes.

Measure B is on the June ballot and continues Cathedral City's existing, voter-approved funding to maintain a fiscally prudent, balanced budget.

Facts about Measure B

Measure B continues local funding for services that include:

- ✓ Retaining City police officers, firefighters, and paramedics
- ✓ Maintaining effective 9-1-1 emergency response services and dispatch operators
- ✓ Maintaining neighborhood police patrols
- ✓ Maintaining local emergency reserve funds

Without Measure B, Cathedral City will lose more than \$4 million in annual revenue.

Measure B does not create a new tax or increase taxes.

Measure B continues funding previously approved by Cathedral City voters to maintain vital city services.
