*In response to Government Code Section 54954.2, members of the Commission may only: 1) respond briefly to statements made or questions posed by the public; 2) ask a question for clarification; 3) make a brief report on his or her own activities; 4) provide a reference to staff or other resources for factual information; 5) request staff to report back to the Commission at a subsequent meeting concerning any matter raised by the public; or, 6) direct staff to place a matter of business on a future agenda. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, **public comments shall be limited to three minutes.***

URGENCY ITEMS

3. ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR

Sponsors: Deanna Pressgrove, Diane Hines

Background: Unless otherwise provided by law, or by ordinance or resolution, each board and commission of the city shall annually at its first meeting held after June 30th, choose one of its number as chairperson and one as vice chairperson. Each chairperson and vice chairperson shall have authority and perform such duties as are commonly associated with their respective titles, or as may be specially prescribed by law or by the bylaws or other rules of the board or commission. Vacancies in either such position occurring prior to July 1st may be filled as in the first instance, and a new chairperson or vice chairperson may be chosen at any time by majority vote of all members of the board or commission. (Ord. 2 § 1, 1981)
