CONDITION OF PERMIT

- 1) Drainage shall be permitted between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., Monday through Thursday.
- 2) Pool water require the pool owner/operator to stop chlorinating the pool for three to seven days, and to test the dechlorinated water for confirmation of an acceptable level of total chlorine residual (0.1mg/L) in the water prior to discharge or drainage.

All the following criteria are to meet:

- Total Residual Chlorine does not exceed 0.1 mg/L (parts per million)
- The pH is between 6.5 and 8.5
- By visual observation the water is free of filter media, vegetative debris, and other materials.

- 3) The permit holder shall be responsible for providing barricades and/or warning device if necessary to protect the public from injury or damages occasioned by the permit equipment or apparatus
- 4) It is the responsibility of the permitholder to make sure the flow of water into streets does not create interference, a traffic safety hazard, or a nuisance to others.
- 5) The permit holder shall also be responsible for damages to public or private party occasioned by the pool drainage.
- 6) The permit holder shall post one copy of this permit at the site and in a location accessible to view of the public.
- 7) The creation of a nuisance shall be cause for revocation of this permit.
